5.1 <u>Program Revision: Intercultural and International Associate of Arts Degree</u> (Motion to Short-cycle; Motion to Approve)

Shaun mentioned this is a very straight forward request to have INST 1100 be added to the Associate of Arts Degree in Intercultural and International Studies, effective Winter 2015. This new course will help create a smoother pathway for students that are wishing to transfer to the SFU International Studies program.
