You are required to demonstrate proficiency in the English language prior to admission to Douglas College. You can do so by providing proof of one of the following (other factors may also be considered):

- B.C. high school English 12: minimum grade C.
- institutional code is 9568.
- TOEFL Essentials: minimum score of 9 (no score below 8 on any individual section).
- IELTS (Academic Module): minimum overall score 6.5. For post-degree and post-baccalaureate diploma programs, minimum score of 6.0 for each band.
- Duolingo 110
- PTE 56
- Successful completion of four courses at ACE Level 2 and three courses at ACE Level 3 at Douglas College.

Note: If you don't meet the English language requirement, you may apply to the English Language Learning and Acquisition program or one to of the ESL Pathway partners.

Other admission requirements such as portfolio submission, audition and volunteering experience are required in some programs.
